Who is it for?

- Government officials or individuals employed by the Government of Bangladesh with at least 2 years of work experience, or individuals engaged in a profession that requires working with the government, or professionals/academicians who analyze public policy, or individuals with a specific academic interest in public policy, governance and development-related area.
- Maximum age limit of 40 years.
- Minimum Bachelor's degree in any discipline from any UGC-authorized university in Bangladesh or abroad, with at least a 2nd Class/Division or CGPA 2.5 out of 4.0 from any government-authorised university.

Note: Candidates with a third division or CGPA of 2.00 at any level of education are not eligible to apply.
